The $\text{\LaTeX} 2_{\epsilon}$ commands `\author`, `\title` and `\date` are commonly used to set the author, title and date of the current document. Once set, these datums are used only by the `\titlepage` command and cannot be retrieved otherwise. The `authoraftertitle` package makes them everywhere available as `\MyAuthor`, `\MyTitle` and `\MyDate`; the original definitions of `\author`, `\title` and `\date` can be accessed using `\Originalauthor`, `\Originaltitle` and `\Originaldate`.
